Unfinished Business:

Ron Suchanek gave an update on the Mother's day breakfast. We served 123 people, 10 less than last, with 53 moms eating free. The expenses were \$437 with \$422 of income. The expenses were a little higher with the addition of a fruit bowl this year. Ron thanked everyone for helping out including lady Knights. We should all give Ron a big thank-you for organizing the event and staying there the entire time. We served about 20 people after the 11:00 A.M. mass. More discussion needs to happen before next year to decide if it's worth the effort to go so late during the day when many Knights need to be with their families.

Duane Kloser gave an update on the St. Patrick's Campout scheduled for July 10th through the 13th at Sunny Side Campground in Foster, Oregon. The cost is \$36 for the 3 nights. It's not too late if you are still interested in going. We have 9 sites reserved, with lots of room for tent sites.

John Meyerhofer gave an update on the fishing trip to his place at Three Rivers. The fishing was great, the weather was great with everyone getting their limit within a couple hours. The number of people attending was down with 13 attending. For the entire group, we caught 109 fish, with the biggest one getting away when Duane was pulling in a 10 inch

kokanee fish with a huge bull trout (keeper larger than 24 inches) in swift pursuit. John was so close to netting it.

Ron Suchanek reported that the 2015 Charity Auction and Crab Dinner procurement forms are available if you want to get a head start on procuring items for the auction.

Duane Kloser gave an update on the irrigation project being organized by Mike Gorka. There has been a delay in the delivery of the vases for the church entrances. They should be here in mid-June. Mike is also working out issues with the City's Planning Commission on the plumbing (irrigation) for the plants around the church grounds. There are issues with back flow devices where they are placed and how the water is used (church or irrigation use). The cost is much higher based on the usage type. There may be options with the 10th street project.

Lastly, Duane Kloser gave an update on the wood cutting project. The Knights donated \$650 for the playground project (wood chips) and we would use sell the wood to reimburse the Knights. We hope to sell the wood for \$150 a cord (customer picks up). Any additional proceeds would be given to the parish.
